The continuing impact of the pandemic throughout 2021/2022 has made it extremely difficult for schools to consistently embed and deepen their new curriculum in all subjects and address all gaps from pupils' previous lost learning.

As a result, we will continue to strive to support schools throughout the continuing curriculum transition period by focusing on the essentials of the curriculum with a range of CPD and specialist support for leaders, teachers and teaching assistants. This will include examples of leadership support materials that may be adapted by school leaders for use in their own setting.

Thank you for your invaluable feedback and suggestions for next year's HART provision. A summary of the feedback is provided below:

Main feedback:

- Continue to provide examples of SEF and school improvement plans.
- Continue to provide evaluative templates to support schools' monitoring and planning.
- Continue to provide regular updates on OFSTED expectation.
- Continue to develop CPD to support schools' implementation of key priorities for improvement and respond to schools' emerging issues.
- Continue to provide support services for schools, for example: focused SLE (Specialist Leaders in Education) visits, headteacher performance management, subject leaders support visits etc.
- CPD to support improvements in subject leadership.
- CPD to support improvements in whole school assessment- is there an effective system aligned across all subjects for the new curriculum?
- CPD to help schools provide a classroom pedagogy that supports pupil remembering and developing fluency.
- CPD supporting SEND pupils to make progress in small steps across all subjects.
- Continue with online HART meetings but include opportunities for face-to-face meetings as we move towards a hybrid model.
- Provide HART CPD for school staff meetings.

Our programme and support for 2022/2023 has responded to members feedback.

We will continue to provide a wide range of support to schools and respond to emerging schools' needs and changing expectation during the year.
